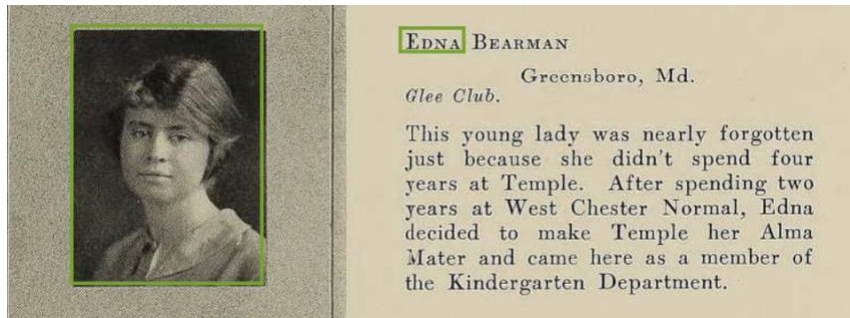

**EDNA B. LeFEVRE**, former principal of South Dover Elementary School, died Wednesday in Silver Lake Nursing & Rehabilitation Center. She was 90 and lived in Dover.

Mrs. LeFevre, a teacher for 37 years, first taught in Lewes and then in Dover public schools for 33 years. She was principal for nine years before retiring in 1965. She was a member and organist for many years at Christ Episcopal Church, and also gave music lessons. Her husband, John LeFevre, died in 1967.
