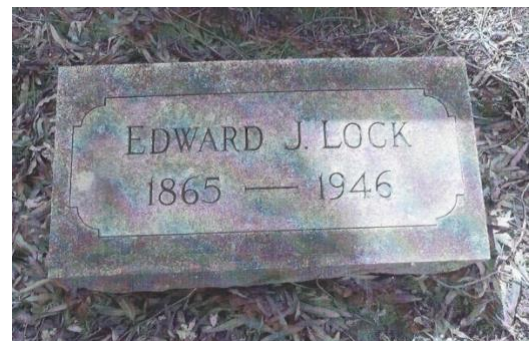

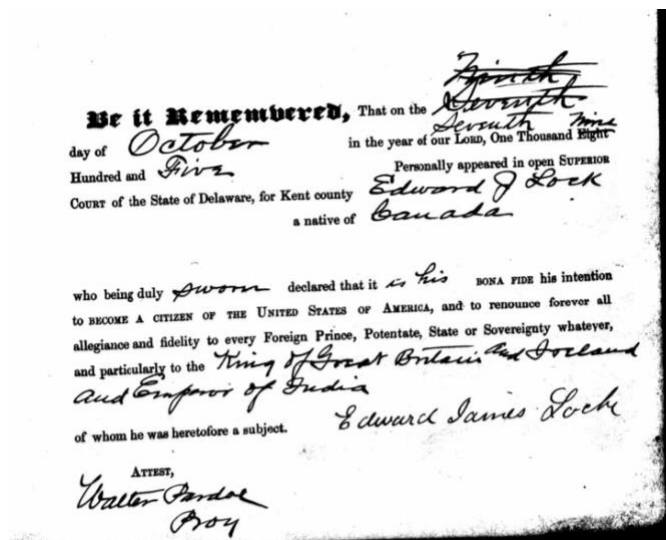

Edward James Lock

HARRINGTON, Jan. 9 — (Special).—Edward James Lock, 80 years old, of Bowers Beach, died early yesterday at the Milford Memorial Hospital where he had been a patient for eight days. Services will be held in Christ Episcopal Church, Dover, tomorrow afternoon at 2 o'clock with the Rev. Paul A. Kellog, rector, officiating. Interment will be in the adjoining cemetery. Friends may call at the Boyer Funeral Home here this evening.

A native of Bristol, England, Mr. Lock came to this country from Canada 40 years ago. He lived on a farm near Dover until moving to Bowers Beach 22 years ago where he operated a marine railway. His wife, Sophie Drew Lock, died about six years ago.

Grandsons will serve as pallbearers at the funeral. He is survived by one daughter, Mrs. Edith Willey, Lebanon, Del., and two sons, Ralph, of Seaford, and Earl, of Bowers Beach, 12 grandchildren, and eight great-grandchildren.
