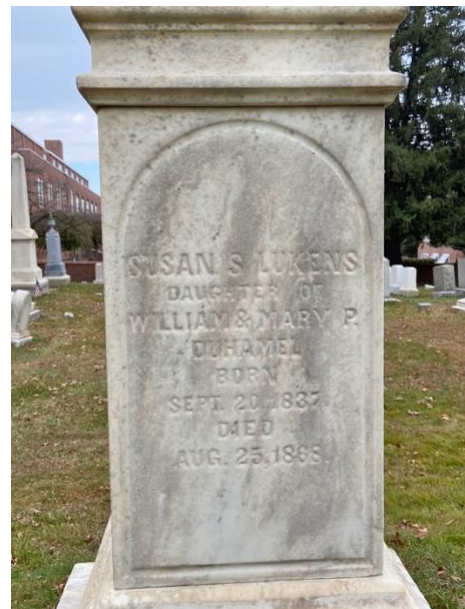

Sealed with our seals, and dated this *Nineteenth* day of *December* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and *fifty nine*

The Condition of the above written Obligation is such, That if *Algerman S. Dupuis* aforesaid, and *Susan S. Johnson* may lawfully unite themselves in marriage, and if there be no legal objection to celebrating the rites of marriage between them, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise to be and remain in force.
