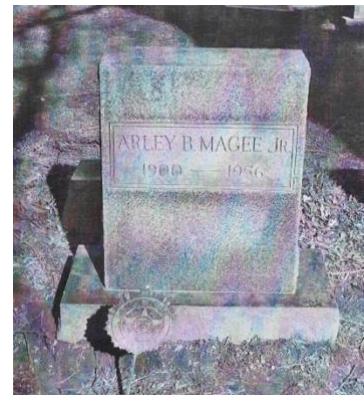

Mr. Hayes gave his niece in marriage. She wore a street length dress of ice blue crepe trimmed with silver lame. Her hat matched her gown and she wore a corsage of orchids.

# Delaware Judge Collapses And Dies

DOVER, Del. (P)—Judge Arley B. Magee Jr. of the Kent County Court of Common Pleas collapsed and died today in the courthouse, apparently of a heart attack. He was 56.

Magee was appointed in 1951 by former Gov. Elbert N. Carvel. His term expired in 1955, but the State Senate failed to confirm as his successor David P. Buckson of Delaware and the George Washington University law school. He was admitted to the bar in 1925.

Survivors include his widow and a daughter, Mrs. Anna Wright of Wilmington.

Funeral services were not complete.
