Obituaries

George Massey dies; was noted genealogist

DOVER — George Valentine Massey, 81, well known Delaware genealogist, died on Tuesday of a heart attack at the Courtland Manor Nursing Home, where he had been a patient for three years. Before entering the nursing home he had lived at 55 King St.

Mr. Massey was a genealogist in the Dover area most of his life. He had traced the histories of many famous Delaware families and was

the author of many genealogical articles and several books, including "The Mitchells and the Days of Philadelphia."

In 1952, the New England Historical and Genealogical Register published his study of Priscilla Kitchen, the ancestor of seven Delaware governors, many Delaware judges, U.S. senators, prominent physicians, bankers, soldiers and members of prominent Delaware families.

Mr. Massey attended Dover High School and Wesley Collegiate Institute.

He is survived by a brother, Robert R. of St. Petersburg, Fla., and a sister, Anna M. Sutton of Wilmington.

Private services will be in Christ Church Cemetery, Dover.
