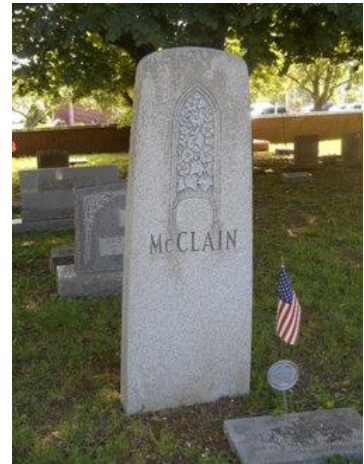

PAUL D. MCCLAIN, 85, of U.S. 13, **Smyrna**, died Friday of heart failure in Veterans Administration Hospital, Elsmere.

Mr. McClain was in the Air Force for 30 years, retiring as a master sergeant in 1954. He was a civilian employee of Dover Air Force Base for 20 years, retiring in 1974. He was an Army Air Corps veteran of World War II and an Air Force veteran of the Korean War.

His wife, Sarah E., died in 1985. He leaves no immediate survivors.

Services will be at 11 a.m. Wednesday in Faries Funeral Chapel, 29 S. Main St., Smyrna, where friends may call from 7 p.m. to 9 p.m. today. Burial will be in Christ Church Cemetery, Dover.
