Dr. McDaniel, Dover Doctor, Dies at 76

DOVER—Dr. Joseph S. McDaniel, 76, died yesterday in Kent General Hospital.

He lived on Manor Drive at Moore's Lake, near Dover.

Dr. McDaniel was graduated from Jefferson Medical College in Philadelphia in 1918.

For 41 consecutive years, Dr. McDaniel was secretary of the State Medical Council and the State Board of Medical Examiners.

He belonged to many civic associations and was a charter member and a founder of the Dover Rotary Club. He belonged to Junior Lodge, A.F. and A.M. and was surgeon for the Dover fire department his entire active career. He also was an active sportsman.

Dr. McDaniel is survived by two sons, Dr. J. Stites McDaniel and William P. McDaniel; two brothers, Dr. Harry McDaniel and H. K. McDaniel; and six grandchildren. All reside in Dover.

Funeral services will be Thursday at 2 p.m. at Ferguson-Hayes Funeral Home here. There will be a viewing at the funeral home between noon and 2 p.m.
