Dolores Jean McQuaide, of Dover, died on Sunday, March 20, 2022.

Jean is survived by her son and daughter-in-law Thomas and Lone Hulliger and their daughters, Laura and Sarah of Metairie, La; her son Edward Bovee of Dover (deceased in 2023); her stepson and daughter-in-law Pete and Ona McQuaide of Middletown; her stepson David McQuaide and his children, Joshua, Ryan and Riley, of Dover. She was preceded in death by her husband Paul "Pete" McQuaide, Jr.; her mother and stepfather Laura (Collins) and Richard Raulston; and her brother Jackie Tucker.

Jean was born in Bridgeville, Delaware on December 14, 1931. In the late 1960s, Jean opened Doll House Nursery and spent many of her years caring for the children of Dover. After owning and operating the nursery for decades, Jean returned to Delaware State University to complete a Master's of Early Childhood Education. She enjoyed baking, attending the theater in Wilmington and caring for her dogs.
