Wm. Paton, Ex-Paterson Banker, Dies

William K. Paton, 65, of Dover, Del., chairman of the board and president of the Farmers State Bank of the State of Delaware, died Tuesday night at Jefferson Hospital, Philadelphia after a short illness.

He was a former vice-president and director of the Paterson Savings Institute, serving in that capacity from 1930 to 1938.

Mr. Paton was born in Paterson on March 6, 1894. He was a graduate of Phillips Exeter Academy, Exeter, N.H. and William College, Williamstown, Mass.

Surviving are his widow, Mrs. Mary Elizabeth Bendig Paton; two sons, William K., Jr., an assistant secretary of the Hanover Bank in New York City and Frederick B., also of New York; and a sister, Mrs. Anna Goodman of Chicago, Ill.
