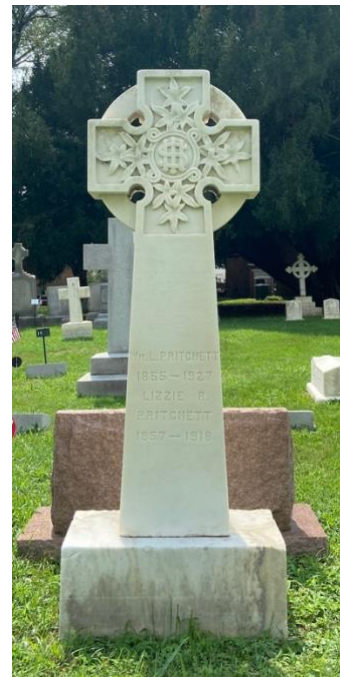

OBITUARY

DOVER, Del., Aug. 12.—The death of Mrs. Lizzie R Pritchett, wife of Undertaker W L. Pritchett, of this town, formerly Miss Lizie Stevenson, which occurred here Saturday after a lingering illness, removes from Dover a member of the well-known Stevenson family who have figured among Dover's citizens for many years. Many years before her marriage she was one of the prominent teachers in Dover's public shools. She is survived besides her husband by one daughter, Mrs. Joseph McDaniel, and one son, Frank Pritchett, in the service of the United States, being in the ordnance department at Edge-wood, Md.

Funeral services will be held from the residence of her nusband tomorrow, Tuesday afternoon at 1 o'clock, with the Rev. Thomas Getz Hill, of Smyrna, Del. officiating. Interment will be made in Christ P E. church-yard.
