WILLIAM L. PRITCHETT DIES AT DOVER HOME

DOVER, Del., April 26.—William L. Pritchett, undertaker, died at his home on State street last evening, aged about 75 years. Mr. Pritchett had been in ill health for several years and since last Friday has been gradually sinking.

He is survived by his widow, who was his second wife, and two children, Mrs. Joseph S. McDaniel, wife of Dr. McDaniel, of this town, and Frank Pritchett, who is working in North Carolina, in the State Highway Department of that State. Mrs. McDaniel and Mr. Pritchett are the children by Mr. Pritchett's first wife, who was Miss Lizzie Stevenson.

On coming to Delaware over 40 years ago, Mr. Pritchett was associated with the late William E. Smith, furniture dealer and undertaker for a time.
