DOVER — James E. Reed, 89, of 31 N. New St., died yesterday in Kent General Hospital, Dover, of a heart attack.

Mr. Reed retired in 1975 after serving for 13 years as a crossing guard on State Street at Wesley College. In past years he was a noted performer in the Dover Minstrel Show.

His wife, Nina, died in 1964. Surviving are two daughters, FRANCES R. Glanden of Wilmington and N. Marie Riddle of Largo, Fla., and five grandchildren.

Services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 1 at the Trader Funeral Home, 12 Lotus St., where friends may call Monday night. Burial will be in Christ Episcopal Church Cemetery, Dover.
