In studying census, marriage and death documents viewed on ancestry.com, it appears that Gertrude's Swedish family was in the USA when she was born (Joplin, Missouri). At some point they returned to Sweden and then came back to the United States. She was married in Massachusetts in 1895, lived there and in Cumberland MD before settling with her family in Hartly, DE. She died on April 22, 1914, just 8 days after her last daughter, Ada Maria was born. She and her husband were buried in the cemetery at St. Martin's Chapel in Hartly, DE. When that church was closed in the mid-twentieth century some of the burials there were reinterred at Christ Episcopal Church in Dover, DE. Her daughter Elsa Rosengren Mitchell paid for the two burial spaces.
