It is my bona fide intention to renounce forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign prince, potentate, state, or sovereignty, and particularly to **Swedish King of Sweden** of whom I am now a subject; I arrived at the port of **New York** in the State of **New York** on or about the **17** day of **August** anno Domini **1873** am not an anarchist; I am not a polygamist nor a believer in the practice of polygamy; and it is my intention in good faith to become a citizen of the United States of America and to permanently reside hereafter.
