Henry Irving Beers Wilson

Age 83, of Henlopen Acres, died at his home Saturday April 29, 2000 after a long illness.

Harry Wilson, as he was known, was born in Dover, DE July 17, 1916 the son of the late Ralph Carmalt Wilson and the late Elizabeth Beers Wilson.

Mr. Wilson was a graduate of The Hill School and attended the Welch Business School. He was the manager of The Pennsylvania Rubber and Supply Co. in Mansfield, OH for 25 years. While living in Ohio he was a member of Kiwanis, the Mansfield Sailing Assoc. and Grace Episcopal Church. He moved to Rehoboth Beach 32 years ago and was employed by Wharton and Barnard until he retired. He was a member of All Saints Episcopal Church, the Rehoboth Beach Country Club, The Henlopen Acres Beach Club, a life member of the Descendants of the Signers of the Declaration of Independence, and the Petrolia Lodge, Number 363.

He is survived by his wife of 59 years, Elizabeth Ross Wilson; a daughter, Katherine Wilson McNeilly of Newburgh, NY; a sister, Edith McMichael of Sarasota, FL; 3 grandchildren, Charles Wilson McNeilly of Baltimore, MD, H.I.B.
