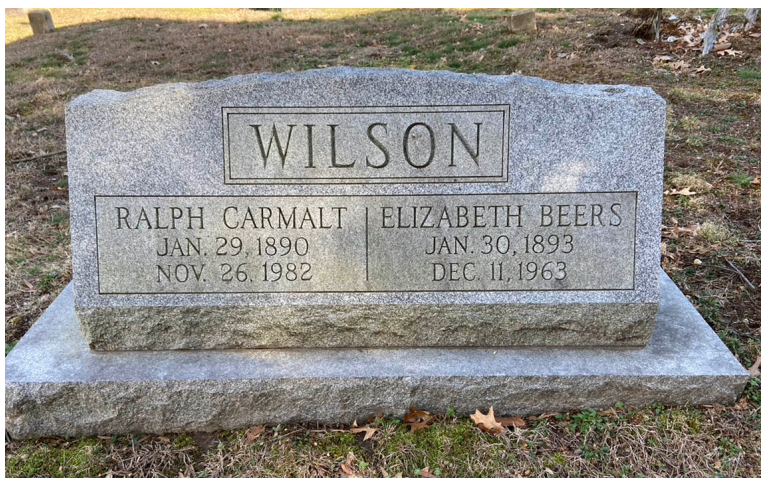

**Wedding of Unusual Interest at Dover.**

DOVER, Del., Oct. 7.—A wedding of social prominence took place here this evening at 8 o'clock, in Christ P. E. church, when Miss Elizabeth Katherine Beers, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. H. I. Beers, Jr., of this town, and granddaughter of Dr. E. S. and Mrs. Anderson, became the bride of Ralph Carmalt Wilson, son of D. M. Wilson, secretary and treasurer of the Delaware R. R., of Dover, and grandson of the late Manlove Hayes.

Mrs. Rigby Vallant, of Philadelphia, a bride of but five days, was matron of honor and Mr. Richard E. Wilson, brother of the groom, was best man.

The bridesmaids included, Miss Margaret Jones and Phyllis Ridgely, of Dover, Miss Lucinda Bradford, Pittsburg, Pa., and Miss Frances Dana, of Marietta, Ohio.

The ushers were Harry McDaniel, Dover; George Chambers, Lewes, Del.; George Pancoast Milligan, Philadelphia; Irving Walla, Smyrna.

Mrs. Helen B. Hughes, of Dover, played the wedding march.

The ceremony was performed by the Rev. Benjamin Fisk Thompson, rector of Christ P. E. church, which included the full service of the Episcopal church.

## Ralph Wilson, ex-agriculture secretary, dies

DOVER — Ralph C. Wilson, 92, of 1 Kings Highway, the former secretary of the State Board of Agriculture, died Friday of heart failure in the Crescent Farm Nursing Home, where he had lived for the past two years.

Mr. Wilson was secretary of the State Board of Agriculture for a quarter of a century, holding the post twice — from 1923 until 1938 and from 1941 until 1950. He presided over the department during a period when it was expanding and assuming new responsibilities in Delaware agriculture.

During the three years he was not serving on the agriculture board, he was Chief Game Warden of the State Fish and Game Commission. He served on the board of directors of the Kent General Hospital, and of the Elizabeth Murphy School.

In 1948, he was named secretary of the Delaware Railroad Co., a post his father, Daniel M. Wilson, had also held.

Mr. Wilson was a life long resident of Dover and a member of the Camden Friends Meeting. He was also a member of the Friends of Old Dover.

His wife, Elizabeth Beers Wilson, died in 1963. He is survived by a son, Harry of Rehoboth Beach; a daughter, Edith McMichael of Sarasota, Fla.; four grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren.

Memorial services will be held Tuesday morning at 11 at Christ Episcopal Church, State and Water streets. Burial will be in the church cemetery. Instead of flowers the family suggests contributions to the Camden Friends Meeting, or Christ Episcopal Church.
